

New CPD Requirements at a Glance

- 2 “planned learning” CPDs
 - What learning you are planning to carry out. What you need to learn may be new knowledge, skills, or a new attitude or approach – anything that you think will make you better able to do your job as a pharmacy professional or prepare you for a new service or role. You should be as specific as possible.
- 2 “unplanned learning” CPDs
 - Describe an unplanned event or activity that enabled you to learn something new or refresh your knowledge or skills

9 CPDs per year	4 CPDs per year
Required to be shown when called upon by GPhC	Required to have been submitted by the time of revalidation <u>each year</u>
Uploaded to www.uptodate.org	Updated to MyGPhC recording tool (live March 31st 2018)

30th of March 2018	31st of December 2018 revalidation pharmacists (cohort 1 year 1)	Members who’s renewal date is the 1st or 15th of every subsequent month	2nd year of revalidation per Pharmacist
New revalidation process comes into effect and updated MyGPhC website goes live	This first cohort is only required to submit 4 CPDs between <u>September 1st 2018 and 31st of October 2018.</u> Nothing else is required	Their 4 CPDs only will start being required to have been officially submitted <u>two months</u> prior to their revalidation date	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 4 CPDs ● Peer Discussion ● Reflective essay Required two months prior to revalidation deadline

New Peer Discussion at a Glance

Provide details of who the Peer you discussed your practice with and their contact information

What to record?

- Why did you choose this peer?
- How this peer discussion has helped you to reflect on and make improvements to your practice?
- Give a real example of any beneficial outcomes for the people using your services as a result of making changes to your practice.
- Do include any feedback about your practice that you have had from other people.

You do not have to include information on the subject(s) discussed if you feel the contents are confidential.

One Account per year

- Reflecting on how you met one or more of the GPhC standards for pharmacy professionals
 - You will be instructed by the GPhC on which standard per year
- State your area of work
 - The setting of your practice
 - Your main roles
- Briefly outline your services typical users
- How did you meet the standard selected
 - Use a real example(s) taken from practice
